

Academic Foundations Math Boot Camp *Summer Semester 2018*

What is the AFM math bootcamp?

An opportunity to quickly brush up on your math skills if you tested into AFM 091, AFM 092, AFM 094 or AFM 097. For two and a half hours a day over four days under the guidance of our AFM instructors, you will work with the computer based MyMathLab program. Completing the assigned modules will qualify you to take a final, proctored test, bringing this to a five-day, on campus commitment. This proctored final test will determine if you are able to move to a higher level course. Attendance is mandatory every day. There is an expectation of student time outside of bootcamp hours which is imperative for success on the final test. Time commitment outside of the bootcamp should be about 2-3 hours a day.

Why would I want to participate in the AFM bootcamp?

- Participating in the AFM bootcamp could result in testing into a higher-level AFM (or math) course and this can save you time and money.
- You believe you did not do your best on the ACCUPLACER math test and want the opportunity to possibly place into a higher-level course.
- Your ACCUPLACER score was a few points from placement in the next level AFM (or MAT) course, and you want the opportunity to possibly place into a higher-level course.
