Make sure they are aware and encourage them to attend the **Career and Co-op Job Fair!**

How can you help?

- Announce Career and Co-op Job Fair in class to students.
- Review tips on how to work a Career Job Fair (page 2)
- Review the list of employers attending with students (page 4)
- Develop an assignment or give extra credit for attendance.
- Do follow-up discussions in class about how your course develops skills needed by employers.
- Discuss the employers and their hiring needs.

Attend yourself

- Network and talk with employers attending.
- Be a "safe" face for your students. When they see you there, they feel more comfortable attending.
- Identify your goal of attending the event (are you looking for information on how your students can better articulate their skill sets; trying to identify companies that would most likely recruit your students; or trying to "sell" your program to potential employers?)
- Questions you may want to ask employers:
 - o What skills are the employers seeking in Cincinnati State students?
 - o What do you like about hiring our students? What skill gaps are you seeing in our students?
 - o How can my student do to stand out when applying for your company?
 - Would you be interested in speaking with classes? How can our department partner with you?
 - Are you open to mentoring students? Providing job shadow experience or informational interviews with students still exploring career options?
 - o Who is the best contact in your organization to speak to about furthering our partnership?

What is a Career and Co-op Job Fair?

A Career and Co-op Job Fair is an event where recruiters and potential employers gather to provide information about their organization and employment opportunities.

- Opportunity to learn about companies.
- Connect with employers who are hiring.
 - Employers attending will have part-time, Co-op/Internship, Full-time Graduate Opportunities available.
- The ability for employers to meet a large number of potential applicants and quickly weed through them to find suitable candidates.

Career and Co-op Job Fairs are Not a Casual Meeting

- Employers do provide information, but they are judging applicants who approach them. (A mini interview)
- They are looking for confidence, assertiveness, and great first impressions.

Before the Career and Co-op Job Fair

- Resume Update and make your resume shine!
- Research Employers Review the employers attending and research information about them.
- Prepare What You Will Wear Business attire.
- **Prepare Questions** Plan what you will ask and how you will interact with employers. How will you communicate your skills to those employers?

Day of the Career and Co-op Job Fair

- Print and Bring Copies of Your Resume on quality resume paper.
- Dress Professionally
- Remember This Is A "Mini" Interview- Be prepared to ask and answer questions.
- Smile and Make Eye Contact
- Watch Your Body Language Don't fidget or look around. Act interested, focused, and enthusiastic. Be friendly, assertive, mature, and sincere.
- Don't Ramble
- Ask At Least Two Intelligent Questions To Each Employer
- Do Not Bring Food, Drink, or Chew Gum at the Fair
- **Network** Not just with the employers but talk to other students about the fair and what they've discussed with employers.
- Bring a Notebook and Pen To take notes
- Gather Business Cards and Company Literature

After the Career and Co-op Job Fair

- Follow Up With Company Representatives
- Send Thank You Notes To the Employers

Questions to Ask Employers:

- What qualities are you looking for in an entry-level candidate?
- What is a typical career path in your organization?
- Why do you love working for your company?
- Describe your application and interview process and what does it consist of?
- What has been your career experience in the industry? As someone going into this industry what suggestions do you have?
- What classes would prepare me for your entry-level positions?
- I want to stay in touch with your recruiting team and continue to learn more about your company. What are your suggestions for me to stay connected?
- What is a typical day like in your organization?
- Are there both full-time and part-time positions available?
