

WHY CAREER SERVICES MATTER

- Increasing Value of a College Education
 - Approx. 80% of students cite the prospect of a "good or better job" as their #1 reason for attending college
 - Graduates who rate their experience with career services as "very helpful" are 5.8x more likely to say their college
 education was worth the cost
- Creating more "hire-able" alumni/student body
 - Only 11% of C-Level business executives are confident in today's graduates as new hires
 - Student demand for career services has risen in recent years by 28%
 - Students who use career services are more likely to receive a paid internship than students who do not
- Equitability
 - Many marginalized students, such as low-income students and first-generation students, rely on career centers to provide information and connections that upper-income students typically have more access to.



PHASE I - SELF ASSESSMENT



- Employment trends based on the greater Cincinnati area.




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



YOUSCIENCE FOCUS ON APTITUDE TO CAREER



- Employment trends on a national and regional level



WHAT RESEARCH IS SHOWING


- After experiencing YouScience aptitude and career discovery, high school students across 5 I schools showed statistically significant positive improvement in the following areas:
- Intent to Persist
- Self-Awareness
- Self-Empowerment

- Career Decision Making

They are also seeing a greater push toward STEM programs than assessments that focus on interest only.






WHO IS CREDITED WITH WRITING THE FIRST RESUME?




HOW STUDENTS CONNECT WITH US

- Students can schedule a virtual appointment with one of our staff members via Starfish under My Success Network.

STARFISH - REFERRALS



- The referral comes to Career Center via Kelly Harper
- We send two initial follow-up outreaches
 - I) Auto-generated email from Starfish
 - 2) Personalized email from the Career Center
 - Who we are
 - Office hours and how to make appointments
 - General overview of the phases of career development
- One of our staff members is assigned to outreach to the student
 - The staff member will make two phone call attempts to reach the student to schedule an appointment.
- Documentation will be recorded in Starfish
